

# CERHS/CWU RUNNING START EQUIVALENCIES

<b>CERHS Graduation Requirements</b>	= <b>Central Washington University Courses</b>
Junior/Senior English	= ENG 101*, ENG 102 and/or 105
Fine Arts	= Any fine, visual or performing arts
Math	= Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II must be completed at the high school
Science	= Any college science course
Washington State History	= POSC 230 State & Local Government
U.S. History	= HIST 144
World History	= HIST 103
Contemporary World Problems	= ECON 101, 102, 201, or GEOG 101
Consumer Family Resources	= UNIV 103 Career Exploration
Health/Fitness I	= EXER 254 or HED 101 + 1 PE Fitness course
Health/Fitness II	= PSY 235 or NUTR 101 + 1 PE Fitness courses
Culminating Project	= The culminating project will be presented during the senior year and will be scored by a panel of judges. It is recommended that students take CWP during spring at CERHS. If they are unable to attend, students will be responsible for completing the project independently and presenting at CERHS during senior project presentations.
Occupation Education	= UNIV 103, HED 101, or NUTR 101
Electives: as chosen	= Electives: as chosen

It is the student's responsibility to verify that they are meeting graduation requirements while enrolled in Running Start.

For purposes of transcripts credits conversion, Cle Elum/Roslyn High School will allow .2 Carnegie Units for each one (1) credit. Example: 5 CWU credit class = 1 Carnegie Unit or CERHS credit.

College coursework of any kind (Running Start, Enrichment) must have advanced approval of the Principal or Counselor in order to qualify for CERHS credit toward graduation. Running Start students should see their counselor regarding class equivalencies for college admissions.

- **English 101 (pass with a C- or better) must be taken before ANY other English course. This is a Central Washington University requirement.**
